GUIDELINES FOR TOURNAMENT

- 1. 8 Teams max. Per grade. First teams paid will be in. Each team is guaranteed (3) games
- 2. ALL WIAA RULES APPLY (WIAA Girls Basketball Used for ALL Grades)
 - Shoot Bonus on 7th Foul of each half / Shoot "Double Bonus" on 10th Foul
- 3. Two 18 Minute Halves Continuous Clock Except for the last 1 minute of the 1st half and last 2 minutes of the game.
 - 2 Full and 1 (30) second time-outs per game / 3-minute half time
 - If tied, the first team to score four points wins the game. / 1-extra time out in overtime session
- 4. We will award <u>12 individual awards</u> to 1st, 2nd place & Consolation champs. (Based on 8 teams)
- 5. 3rd & 4th Grade will shoot free throws from 12 feet.
- 6. <u>There will be No Zone Defense or Press</u>. (Can press last two minutes of game, but must be man to man press. You cannot press if you are up by 15 points)
 - **Double-Teaming** is allowed when the ball is in the lane, when a player is attacking the basket, and anytime the ball is in the low or high post until there is a shot, a pass or a turnover. After the pass there must be an attempt by the defense to recover and find the man they were initially covering.
 - **Sagging/Helping** is allowed in the lane if the ball is on one side of the court and defensive man's person is on the other side of the court. Example: a clear out for one player or if a team runs to one side of the court and sends players opposite as decoys. The defensive team must not be penalized for playing good man to man defense if the offensive team has players who are not involved in the offensive play.
- 7. The Slinger Recreation Department & Slinger School District will not be held liable for any injuries, to any players or spectators, occurring during the tournament.
- 8. WIAA referees will officiate each game. Coaches, players and fans are asked to show courtesy and demonstrate good sportsmanship throughout the tournament. Anyone unable to follow guidelines and display good sportsmanship will be asked to leave for the remainder of the tournament.
