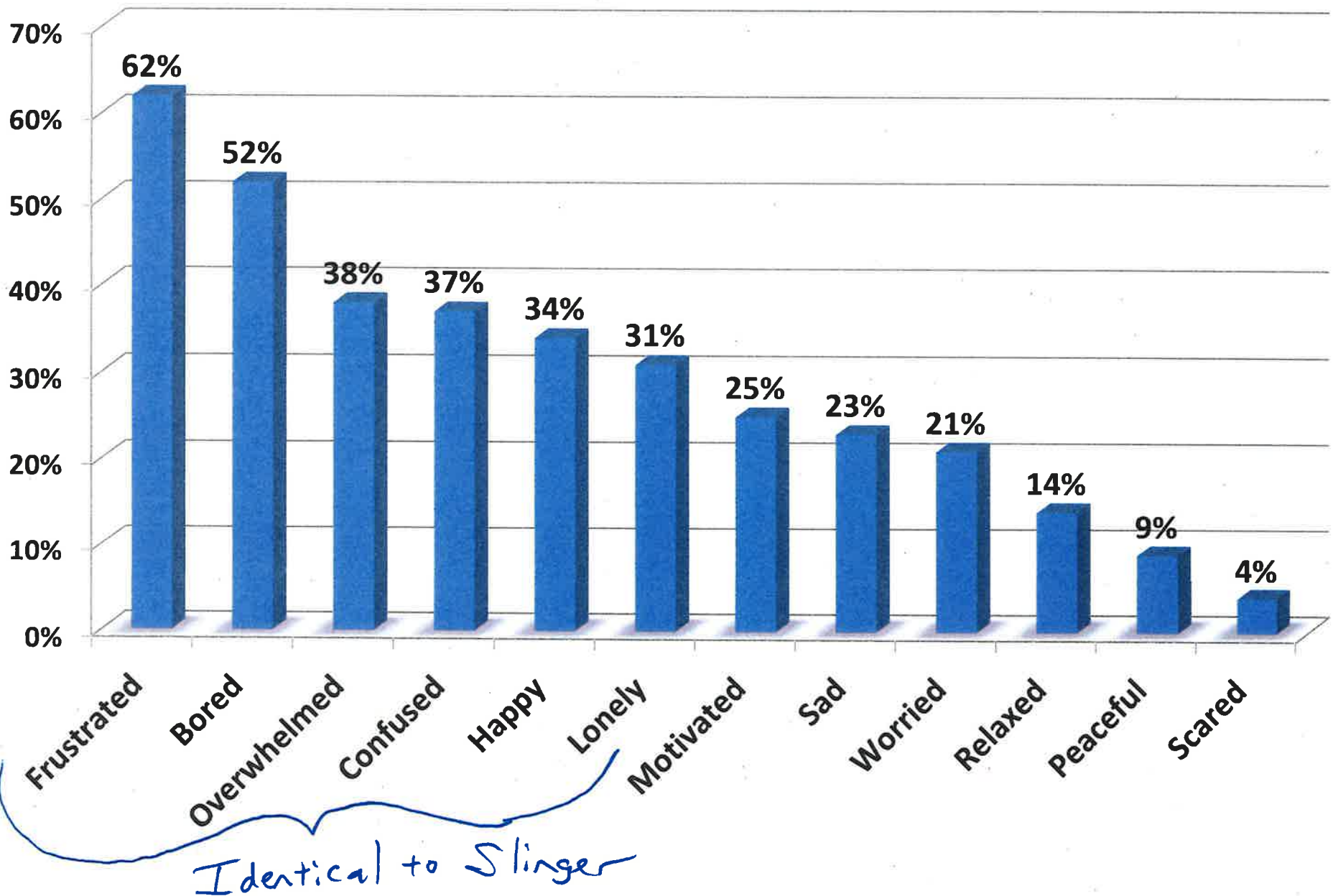

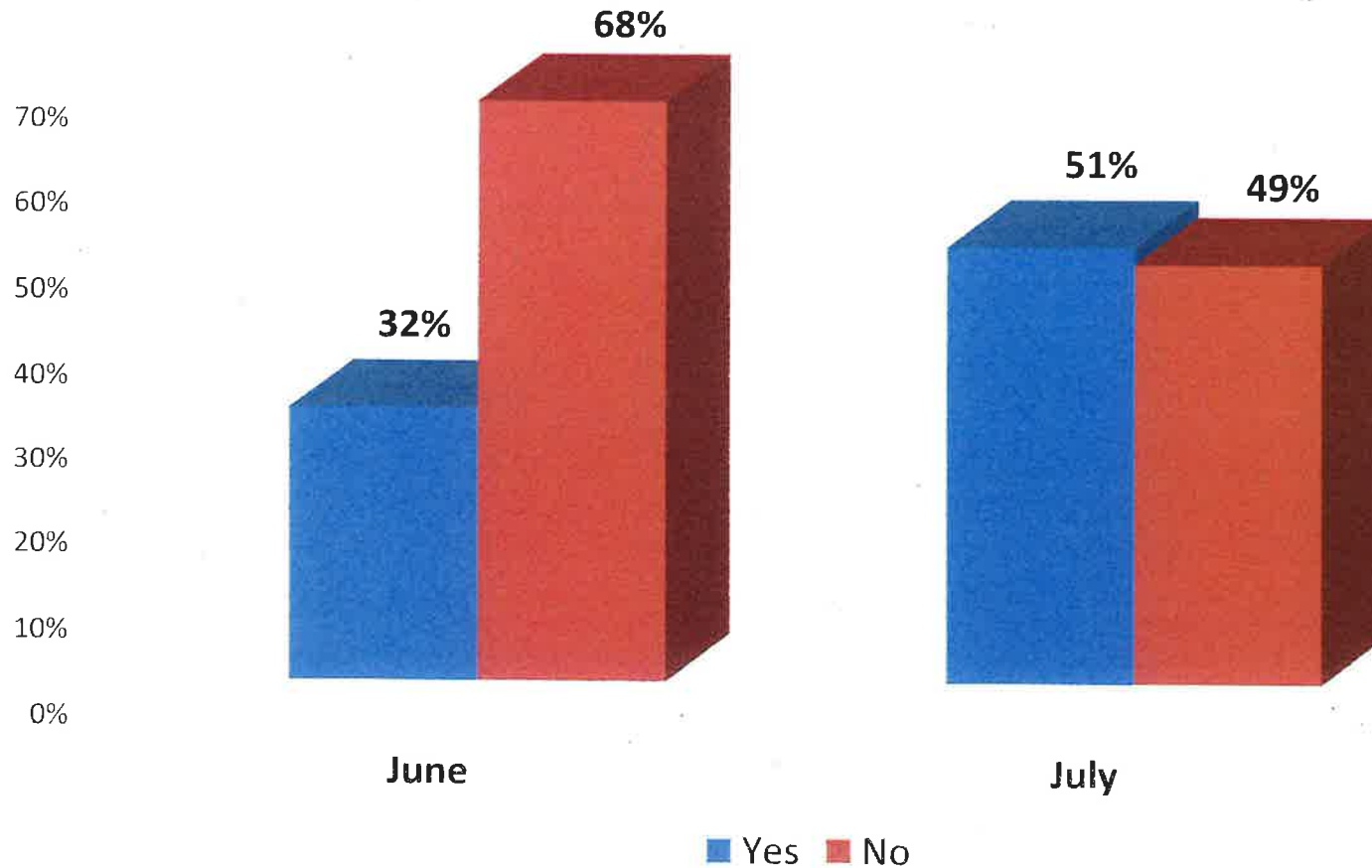
The Slinger School District's mission is to successfully educate all children and, thereby, to graduate high quality, lifelong learners who are college and career ready. To do so, the district is committed to:

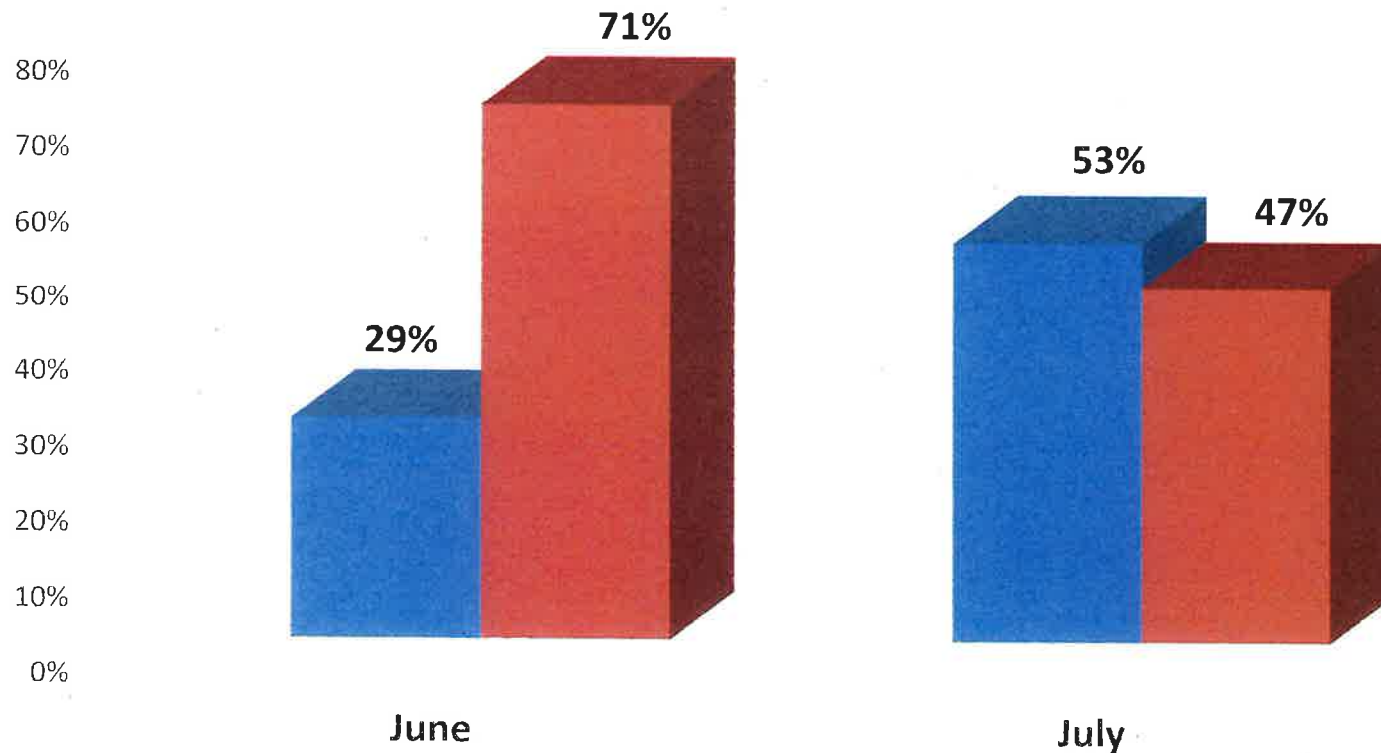
Do you believe the District should require all staff to wear masks during the school day and at school-sponsored events when social distancing is not able to be maintained?

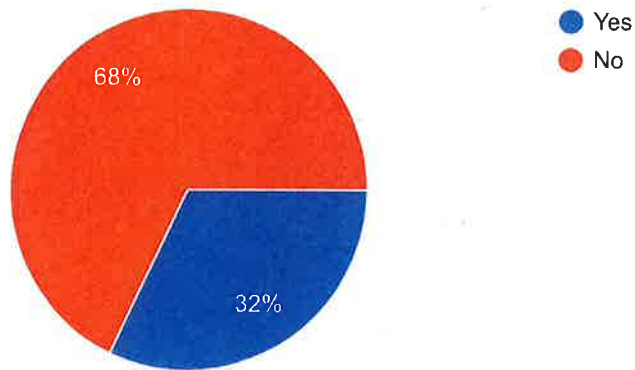

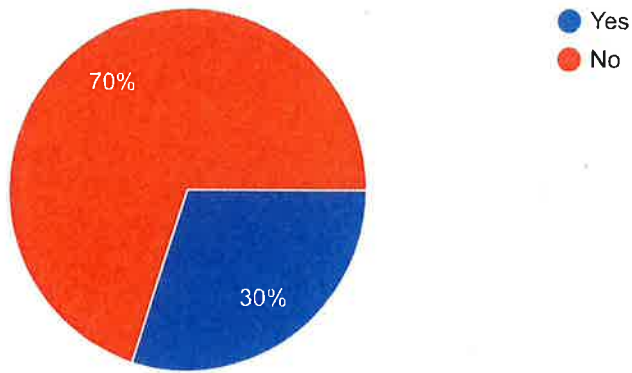
Will you do daily temperature checks?

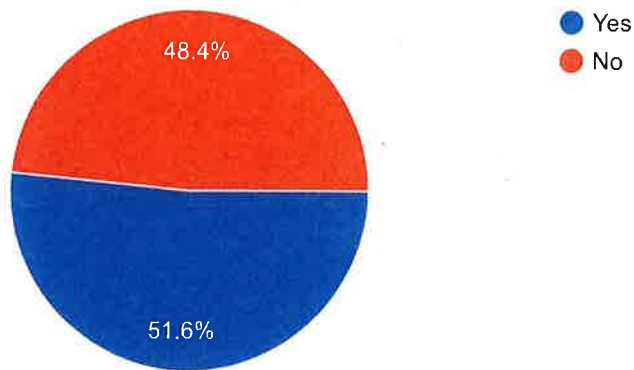
Will you mandate masks for students at the elementary level?

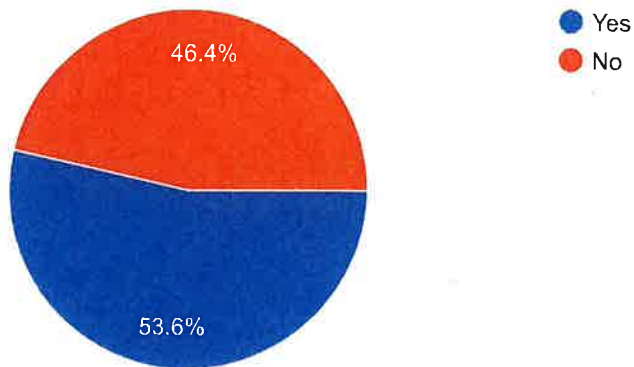
Will you mandate masks for students at the middle level?

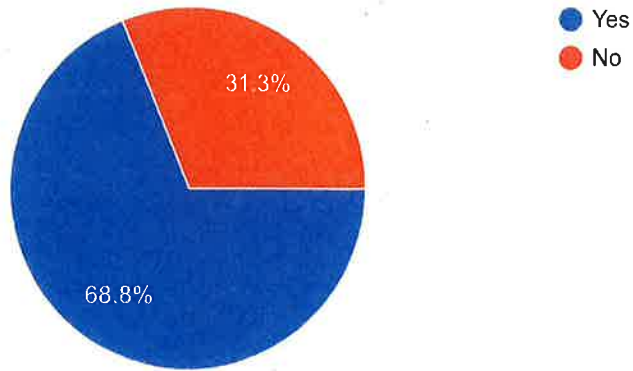
Will you mandate masks for students at the high school level?

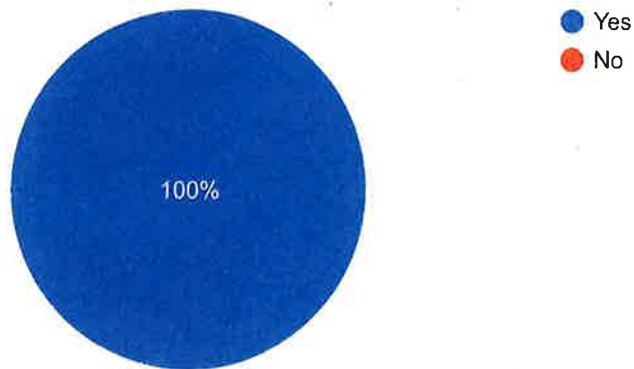
Will you mandate masks for staff?

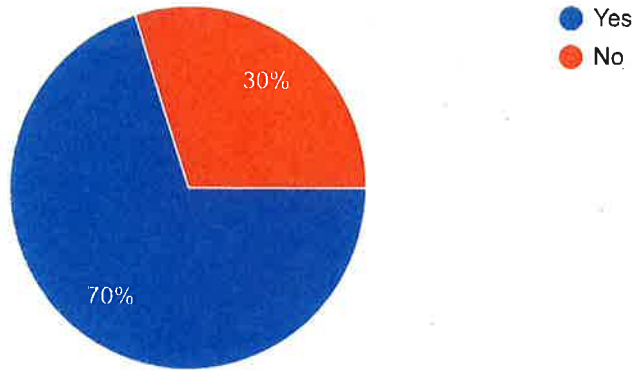
Will your district expect contact tracing if there are students/staff that are positive?

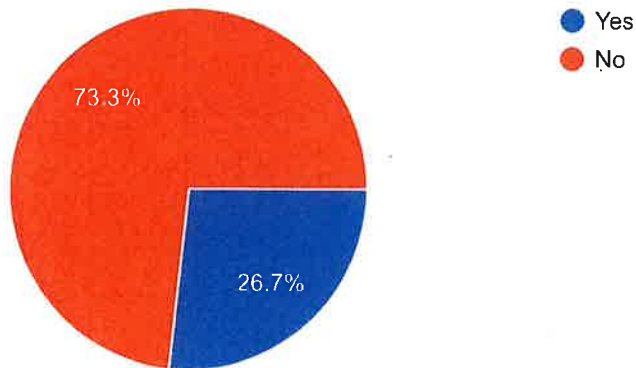
Will you mandate quarantines for students/staff for exposure if they show no symptoms?

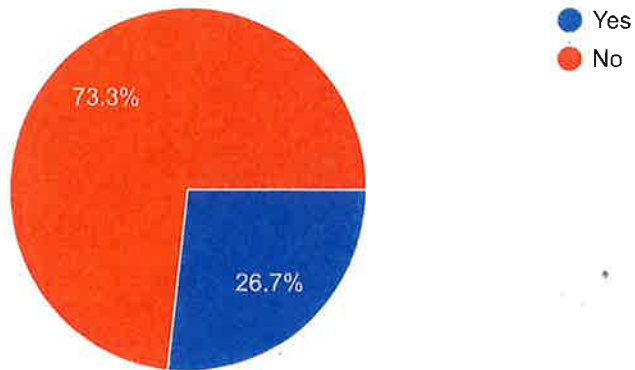
Will you have a student travel policy i.e. "have you traveled out of state in the last 14 days?"

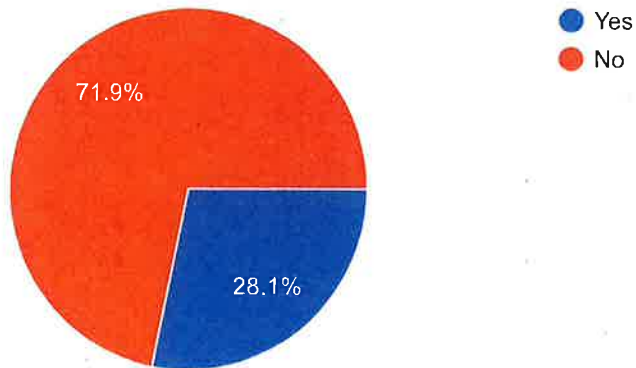
Will you have a staff travel policy i.e. "have you traveled out of state in the last 14 days?"

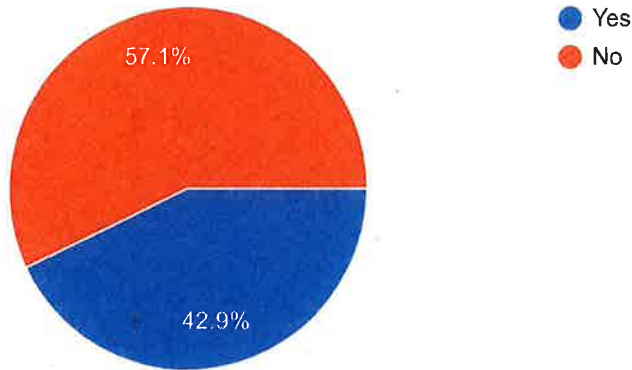
Have you developed a specific leave policy related to staff that may have been exposed or are diagnosed positive?
