Plans will be developed to allow for a fluid response keeping in mind staff, student and parent capacity, coupled with financial resources of the District.



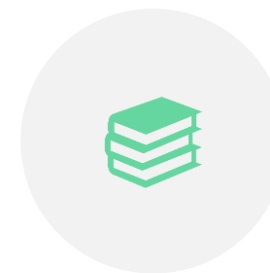
SAFETY

Student and Staff Safety is a top priority. Plans will reflect guidance from the CDC, State and Washington/Ozaukee County Health Departments.

Plans will reflect a preference for traditional and virtual classroom learning and focus on creating conditions to safely reopen schools. Instructional models will include in person and virtual options for K-12 in the event that traditional classroom learning cannot occur.

EDUCATIONAL OPTIONS



We will be operating with full capacity in the Fall. We will use mitigating procedures to reduce the potential spread of Covid-19 and other diseases.



Parents who wish to remain with distance learning may do so for the time being and we will provide for this to the best of our abilities. We will be providing a digital platform for our parents to access courses. Ace Digital will be used for grades 5K-5 and Apex Learning will be used for grades 6-12. Please understand that these students will still be Slinger School District students but will not be assigned to a current Slinger teaching staff member. We will hire certified staff to monitor progress and for the personal communication.



Hybrid- For those students who would feel more comfortable using a mix of face to face and the digital platform



Students who are ill or need to be quarantined will continue to receive instruction and support from their classroom teacher via electronic means.

General Infection Control Measures

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- INCREASED SCHOOL NURSING SERVICES
- BUILDING AND GROUNDS STAFF TRAINED AND RECEIVED INFECTIOUS DISEASE CONTROL CERTIFICATION
- DETERMINED AND HAVE SET UP TRAINING FOR LEARNING MANAGEMENT PLATFORMS SHOULD REMOTE LEARNING BE REQUIRED IN THE FUTURE
- PPE ITEMS HAVE BEEN ORDERED INCLUDING HAND SANITIZER DISPENSERS FOR CLASSROOMS WITHOUT HAND WASHING CAPABILITIES, FACE SHIELDS FOR STAFF.
- UPGRADING OF FACILITIES TO MEET NEW EXPECTATIONS:
 - *50 SELF METERING, HYGIENIC FAUCETS HAVE BEEN ORDERED AND WILL BE INSTALLED THIS SUMMER
 - *PURCHASING AND INSTALLING MORE OF THE “BOTTLE FILL” DRINKING STATIONS. ORDERED ONE TIME USE CUPS FOR THOSE WHO FORGET WATER BOTTLES.
- ORDERED MORE TECHNOLOGY TO MEET INCREASED DEMAND I.E. CHROMEBOOKS AND WIFI HOTSPOTS
- PURCHASED PROTECTIVE SHIELDS FOR RECEPTION DESKS

Additional Infection Control Measures

- USE THE "REOPENING SCHOOL BUILDING RISK ASSESSMENT" TO ENSURE MITIGATION STRATEGIES ARE IN PLACE.
- ALL STAFF WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR A MASK, FACE SHIELD OR HAVE A PHYSICAL BARRIER AT THEIR WORKSTATION WHEN WITHIN SIX FEET OF OTHERS. FACE SHIELDS AND BARRIERS HAVE BEEN ORDERED.
- STUDENTS WILL BE EDUCATED AND ENCOURAGED TO WEAR A MASK IF PHYSICALLY ABLE AND WILL OBSERVE SOCIAL DISTANCING WHERE POSSIBLE. MASKS HAVE BEEN SECURED FOR STUDENTS AND STAFF.
- PROVIDE PARENT EDUCATION ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF MONITORING SYMPTOMS, WEARING MASKS, AND STAYING HOME WHEN ILL. ENCOURAGE PARENTS TO PERFORM SYMPTOM CHECKER WITH CHILD BEFORE COMING TO SCHOOL. ENSURE ALL FAMILIES HAVE ACCESS TO THERMOMETERS AND FACIAL COVERINGS. SUPPLY THERMOMETERS (IF IN SUPPLY) AND FACIAL COVERINGS IF NEEDED.
- SCHOOL NURSES DESIGNATED SICK STUDENT/ADULT LOCATIONS IN EACH BUILDING TO MINIMIZE CONTACT.
- INCREASED OUTSIDE AIR CIRCULATION THROUGHOUT THE BUILDINGS.
- WORK WITH SAFETY TEAM TO EXAMINE THE DOOR POLICY.
- MAINTAIN CLEANING SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS FOR CLASSROOM, STUDENT, STAFF USE.
- INCREASE CLEANING OF ALL AREAS WITH EMPHASIS ON HIGH TOUCH SURFACES.
 - Use of electrostatic sprayers and advanced anti-viral chemicals.

- TEMPERATURE/SYMPTOMS CHECK BY PARENTS
- 100.4 DEGREES OR ABOVE STAY HOME
- OTHER FLU LIKE SYMPTOMS SHOULD STAY HOME AS WELL

BUS

- HAND SANITIZER AVAILABLE
- MASKS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED
- SIBLINGS SIT TOGETHER
- LOAD FROM BACK TO FRONT
- STUDENTS SIT BY THE WINDOW
- FACE FORWARD
- KEEP WINDOWS OPEN DURING NICE WEATHER
- INCREASE CLEANING IN BETWEEN ROUTES

ENTRANCE

- UTILIZE MULTIPLE ENTRANCES
- NO VISITORS ALLOWED
- NO SHARING OF LOCKERS
- MASKS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED
- HYGIENE SIGNAGE

CLASSROOM

- HAND SANITIZER AVAILABLE WHEREVER HANDWASHING STATIONS ARE NOT AVAILABLE
- HYGIENE SIGNAGE
- SEATING MAY BE MODIFIED
- MASKS RECOMMENDED WHEN SOCIAL DISTANCING CANNOT BE MAINTAINED
- LIMITING USE OF SHARED MATERIALS
- CLEANING SUPPLIES AVAILABLE TO TEACHER

RECESS

- RESTRICT AREAS OF PLAY BY GRADE LEVEL
- INCREASED CLEANING OF EQUIPMENT
- IN INCLEMENT WEATHER- INDOOR RECESS WILL BE IN CLASSROOM WITH MINIMAL CROSS MINGLING

LUNCH

- NEW SERVING LINE FORMATION
- HAND SANITIZER IN LUNCH ROOMS
- SCANNERS FOR POINT OF SALE
- NEW ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL PROCEDURES
- EXPANDING EATING AREAS TO ALLOW FOR MORE SOCIAL DISTANCING

SPECIALS

- 33% TEACHER WILL HELP ONLINE FOR GRADES K-5 SINCE ACE DIGITAL DOES NOT HAVE ELECTIVES
- EACH DEPARTMENT HAS MITIGATION PLAN

DISMISSAL

- UTILIZE MULTIPLE EXITS
- NO VISITORS ALLOWED
- NO SHARING OF LOCKERS
- MASKS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED
- HYGIENE SIGNAGE

EXTRA-CURRICULAR

- RELY ON GUIDANCE FROM THE WIAA
- ASSUMING SCHOOL IS ABLE TO RESUME- SPORTS, CLUBS, ETC.. WILL TAKE PLACE WITH SAFETY MEASURES IN PLACE
- ACTIVITIES MAY NEED TO BE POSTPONED OR ADJUSTED TO MEET LATEST GUIDELINES
- COACHES AND ADVISORS WILL COMMUNICATE PLANS WITH PARENTS AND STUDENTS

KOOL KIDS

- MASKS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED
- SOCIAL DISTANCING IF POSSIBLE
- WORK WITH MAINTENANCE ON EXTRA CLEANING PROCEDURES

Typical School Events

WHEN POSSIBLE THESE WILL BE HELD VIRTUALLY.
