

The School Board of the School District of Slinger derives its authority to govern the local schools directly from the Wisconsin Constitution and the statutes of the legislature. However, the board also recognizes that, by custom and tradition, it has a responsibility to the citizenry it serves and the persons it employs to discharge its duties and obligations in a manner that will ensure the highest possible educational level of the citizens of the district.

The board accepts its role as the policy making body for the district and declares its intent to perform this function within the framework of the law and the will of the local citizenry.

The board shall consist of seven members, elected at large by a plurality vote cast by the qualified electors of the school district.
