

The president of the Board of Education may appoint members to standing committees to study matters given particular to their definition and make recommendations to the full Board on their findings. Other committees may be appointed to deal with specific items or issues on an ad-hoc basis as deemed necessary by recommendation of the district administrator and/or by consensus of the full board.

Standings committees shall be as follows:

1. Budget
2. Building and Grounds
3. Curriculum
4. Human Resources
5. Policy
6. Transportation

Mindful of the rights and responsibilities of the public to the public education system, the Board may from time to time, request citizens of the district to serve on an advisory committee. The purpose and scope of each committee shall be outlined in a mission statement prepared and approved by the Board.

Recommendations and funding shall be presented to the Board as advisory. A member(s) of the board shall serve as a voting member(s) on the committee, and as liaison to the Board president. Administrator(s) and teacher(s) shall be appointed as appropriate to the committee's mission.

Public notice of committee meetings shall be given in accordance with state law and established procedures.
