

A Slinger High School student, who has not completed the requirements for graduation, may earn a high school diploma after the graduation date of the student's class by completing the graduation requirements for that student's graduating class identified on the student's transcript by following these guidelines:

1. A credit deficient student may continue in the high school's regular education program through the semester in which the student turns 20 years old, with approval of the high school principal.
2. Any student may earn high school credits toward a Slinger High School diploma through technical college, college, university, or other accredited schools with prior approval of such coursework by the high school principal.
