A Slinger High School student, who has not completed the requirements for graduation, may earn a high school diploma after the graduation date of the student's class by completing the graduation requirements for that student's graduating class identified on the student's transcript by following these guidelines:

- 1. A credit deficient student may continue in the high school's regular education program through the semester in which the student turns 20 years old, with approval of the high school principal.
- 2. Any student may earn high school credits toward a Slinger High School diploma through technical college, college, university, or other accredited schools with prior approval of such coursework by the high school principal.
