Generally, commercial films produced for entertainment are not to be shown in schools during instructional time. Films or videotapes having obvious educational value may be shown when appropriate for the content, district curriculum, and level of the subject being taught. Commercial films may be shown for entertainment as part of co-curricular or after school event or as a reward for a class achieving a major goal provided the film is obtained with proper licensure.

In addition to a film's content being appropriate for the subject taught, films will have the appropriate rating required for the student audience or have administrative and prior parent/guardian approval for a student to view the film.
