STUDENT FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES

Policy 374

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It is the policy of the Board of Education to restrict and limit the use of the school's name, its buildings or premises, in solicitations and fund raising activities.

Therefore, solicitations and fund raising activities by commercial enterprises, parent groups, and student members of school clubs and organizations in the name of the school to be carried on outside of the school buildings must have the expressed approval of the Board.

Solicitations and fund raising activities carried on by student members of school clubs and organizations within the school buildings shall be permitted only with the approval of the principal and the district administrator.

No child under the age of 12 may participate in any fundraising activity (door-to-door sales) unless he/she has written parental permission. Children under the age of nine must be accompanied by a person 16 years of age or older when participating in fundraising activities.
