

The School District of Slinger recognizes “virtual” or “online” education as an appropriate means for achieving elements of the school district’s educational mission. Online instruction is viewed as a method for the District to enhance or expand course offerings and to provide an educational alternative better suited to meet the learning needs of a diverse population of students.

Virtual educational opportunities must have an identifiable curriculum and must be instructed/facilitated by either a licensed instructor or by an instructor who is authorized by an accredited educational institution. Virtual courses of study must comply with the State of Wisconsin’s academic standards and/or national educational standards. In addition, virtual curriculum must comply with the District’s graduation requirements. Relative to the application of virtual education for pre-college credits, a virtual course of study must comply with the standards of the College Board’s Advanced Placement (AP) curriculum.
