STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS

Policy 371

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Student clubs, organizations, and intramural athletics are encouraged when they meet the simple criteria of contributing to the education and the wellbeing of the student. Guidelines for the formation of a club or organization are as follows:

- 1. The permission of the building principal to establish the club or organization.
- 2. The assignment of at least one faculty advisor to each club or organization.

All funds for clubs and organizations will be maintained in the students' activity account. The building principal will keep the district administrator informed on the status of all clubs and organizations.

Approval of the Board is required for any organization that require the expenditures of district funds or that may engage in activities of a divisive or controversial nature.

The Slinger School District shall not discriminate in admission to any program or activity, standards and rules of behavior, disciplinary actions or facilities usage on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. This policy does not, however, prohibit the district from placing a student in an activity based on objective standards of performance, from providing separate programs in interscholastic athletics for males and females if such programs are comparable in type, scope and support from the District, or from providing separate toilet, locker and shower facilities. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
