The Board recognizes that the state legislature permits and that parents desire students to be released from school for religious instruction. Therefore, students in the School District of Slinger will be released for religious instruction under the following conditions:

1. Each student must have written permission from his/her parent or guardian. The written statement must indicate the location of instruction.
2. The Board may deny the privilege of released time to students who absent themselves from religious instruction after requesting the privilege.
3. Not more than one hour per week of school time may be granted for religious instruction.

The Board assumes no responsibility for transporting students to religious instruction classes. Furthermore, the District is released from all liability under state law for students who have been released from school for religious instruction.
