ADMISSION OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS

Policy 422

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Future Resident Students:

Upon proper application, the children of families who expect to become residents of the district during a given semester and who have signed a contract to buy, build, or lease a residence in the district, shall be admitted to school on or after the beginning of a semester during which they expect to become residents. No tuition shall be charged. Tuition will be charged at the corresponding open enrollment rate. If residency is established in the agreed upon semester then the tuition will be returned. Transportation shall be the responsibility of the parent or guardian.

Former Resident Students:

We will follow state guidelines for non-resident tuition waivers. Additional year tuition waivers shall be granted to the extent required by state law. A student who moves out the District may apply to continue his/her enrollment in subsequent years in accordance with state law and open enrollment board policy 423.

In either case, transportation shall be the responsibility of the parent, guardian, or student.
