

412 FULL TIME STUDENTS

Full-time students are defined as students of legal school age who attend school during the normal school hours of the school they are assigned and attend classes or programs unless excused by the Board as authorized by state statute. This definition also includes any District students who are enrolled or participating in any alternative educational programs because they are students at risk, school-aged parents, truants, or are excused from school to participate in a program leading to high school equivalency. Students attending a nonresident public school district on a full-time basis under the open enrollment law, sections 118.51 of the statutes are also included in this definition.
