

422 ADMISSION OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS

(Other than open enrollment students)

Future Resident Students

Upon proper application, the children of families who expect to become residents of the district during a given semester and who have signed a contract to buy, build, or lease a residence in the district, shall be admitted to school on or after the beginning of a semester during which they expect to become residents. No tuition shall be charged. Transportation shall be the responsibility of the parent or guardian.

Former Resident Students

All students who were residents of the district on the second Friday in January of the previous year and were enrolled in the school district continuously from the second Friday of January through the end of that school year, yet ceased to be a resident after the first Monday in February of the previous school year, shall be allowed to continue their enrollment for the current school year without payment of tuition.

All students who are residents of the district on July 1, may finish the following school year without payment of tuition even though their parents move out of the school district before the close of the school year, providing a suitable resident guardian relationship is arranged. Additional year tuition waivers shall be granted to the extent required by state law. A student who moves out the District may apply to continue his/her enrollment in subsequent years in accordance with state law and open enrollment board policy 423.

In either case, transportation shall be the responsibility of the parent, guardian, or student.
