

443 STUDENT CONDUCT

Students in the School District of Slinger shall be expected to act in such a manner that their behavior will reflect favorably on the individual student and on the school, showing consideration for fellow students and creating a positive, cooperative school atmosphere. Each student must recognize individual responsibilities and obligations and discharge them in accordance with school regulations.

Students are expected to abide by the codes of conduct as outlined in student handbooks, and/or as stated in the rules and regulations established in each school.

All employees share responsibility for supervising the behavior of students and for seeing that they meet the standards of conduct established in the school. In instances where an employee is acting to help a student conduct him/herself in a proper manner, emphasis will be placed on the enabling of the student to grow in his/her capacity to exhibit self-control.

The District shall not discriminate in standards and rules of behavior, including student harassment, on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be handled in accordance with established procedures.
