

447 STUDENT DISCIPLINE

Students of the School District of Slinger are expected to follow all rules and regulations that are established for them by the District, and by the staff and administration of their respective schools.

Corrective discipline, disciplinary sanctions, and reasonable procedures may be imposed upon students who violate school rules. Whenever possible, a positive approach in disciplinary measures shall be used, taking into account a respect for the student, the seriousness of the infraction, and the need for positive motivation for students. This approach includes open communication with parents/guardians, teachers, and appropriate behavior specialists and cooperating agencies.

The School District of Slinger shall not discriminate in standards or rules of behavior or disciplinary measures, including suspensions and expulsions, on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
