

656 STUDENT FEES, CHARGES, AND FINES

The Board of Education may levy certain charges to students to facilitate the utilization of adequate, appropriate learning materials used in the course of instruction. Parents/guardians who claim that the financial conditions of their families are such that they cannot afford to pay the established fees may request that the fees be waived. All fee waivers shall be considered for approval by the building principal.

Students shall be charged a rental fee for the use of textbooks and other selected instructional materials

Students in Grades K through 6 shall be furnished with selected consumable materials such as workbooks when they are used as basic textbooks. Students in Grades 7 through 12 shall be required to purchase all consumable materials.

General materials fees shall be charged in, but not limited to, selective classes such as Family and Consumer Education, Art, Woods, Metals, Art, Photography, and Driver Education.

Students shall be assessed fines for overdue instructional and library materials and shall be responsible for replacement costs for damaged or lost materials.
