

Support services are essential to successful functioning of a school system. Management of auxiliary operations is an important responsibility of the district administrator and should be managed in coordination with, and in support of, the central function of education.

Therefore, the Board establishes these broad goals of support services:

1. To provide a physical environment for teaching-learning that is safe and pleasant for students, staff and public;
2. To provide safe transportation for students to and from school and nutritious meals for students; and,
3. To provide services and assistance that is responsive in terms of timeliness and degree of fulfillment of the needs of the educational program as they develop.
