

Accident prevention and reporting serves to support the safety of all students and employees and supports the safe and efficient operation of the school district. Proper reporting shall be required as protection for the District.

Accidents involving students must be reported in writing to the building principal. Accidents or injuries involving employees shall be reported to the employee's immediate supervisor.

In order to expedite prompt and appropriate medical attention and to facilitate processing of insurance claims, all accidents and injuries occurring on school grounds or while under school supervision shall be reported on District provided forms immediately to the District Office by the principal or immediate supervisor, except under extenuating circumstances and if necessary submission to the District's liability insurance carrier.

Principals and maintenance personnel shall inspect and care for the property which they are assigned and address reasonable school safety concerns for prevention of accidents.
