

881.2 RELATIONS WITH BOOSTER/PARENT ORGANIZATIONS

The Board of Education identifies Booster/Parent Organizations as important partners with the school district to promote and enhance school programs and activities. These organizations are defined as any not-for-profit organizations, organized to support curricular, extra-curricular, or co-curricular activities of the school district (e.g., athletics, music, etc.).

The Board of Education welcomes these efforts by parents and community to provide support for the students involved in their respective programs. However, because of the partnership, there needs to be an understanding of certain federal/state laws, WIAA rules and regulations, and school policies and procedures to protect parent/community members, school staff, students and the school district as a whole. Guidelines (found in Policy 881.2 Rule) are to be shared with all Booster/Parent Organizations.
