School Days

Arrival and Dismissal

Student supervision begins at 8:20AM for the lobby and front crosswalk.

Students should not arrive earlier than 8:20AM.

All students need to be in their seats and ready to learn by 8:45AM. Students who arrive to school after 8:45AM may be marked tardy/late.

First bell for dismissal is at 3:30PM.

All students should be off school grounds immediately following dismissal and no later than 3:45PM as there is no supervision past that time. If you are not able to pick your child up by 3:45PM please contact Kool Kids Club for after school care options.

4K arrival and dismissal is separate from the rest of our student body. Your child's teacher will provide details of their arrival and dismissal procedure.
