Slinger High School and Kettle Moraine Youth Aviation, Inc. have teamed up to offer a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to build this RV-12 aircraft. After completing our first RV-12 Airplane, KMYA is now including Slinger HS students in our program. Through participation in the Aviation Club you will learn how to rivet, measure, cut, bend and shape aluminum into a real aircraft. The RV-12 seats two, and cruises at 130 mph. It is capable of traveling up to 500 miles non-stop. Learning through doing.

The building process is a TEAM endeavor, and through hands on experience you will learn to read plans, measure, organize, and work with others in a collaborative way to achieve an ambitious goal: Building and flying a real aircraft! We also recently were gifted a 1941 J-3 Cub to use for flight lessons at a discounted rate. Students will have the chance take lessons to earn their private pilot license. Private Pilot Ground School classes will be offered over the summer.
