The primary role of an Educational Interpreter is to provide tutorial support, under the direction of a student's teachers, in order to allow equal access to instruction, using American Sign Language (ASL), English-based sign forms and/or other visual communication.

- Possess some knowledge of current PK-12 curricular, instructional philosophy and practice, and special education law and practice; and,
