The curriculum meeting was called to order by Brenda Lighthizer at 6:22 PM in the High School IMC.

1. The Board heard updates related to various curriculum review cycles
 - a. Math: Metke shared an update on the two programs that will be fully implemented at the elementary and middle school as well as some growth data from the pilot groups. 3-8 data will be shared in October or November when the state assessment data is unembargoed.
 - i. Eureka Squared, 4K-5th
 - ii. Illustrative Mathematics, 6-8
 - b. ELA: Brooks shared an update on ACT 20. AimsWEB Plus has been selected as the statewide reading readiness screener. Teams are meeting with the vendor next week to plan for the winter implementation. Elementary teachers will participate in 6.5 hours of early reading development training on August 29th. This will be the beginning of the 40-hour state-required training previously discussed.
 - c. Counseling: Brooks reviewed the counseling goals that were identified through the program review last year and follow up on the next steps
 - i. Middle school teachers have been trained in Character Strong. Lutter has communicated out lessons for parents to review (June and August). She will have ongoing communication (monthly) in her school newsletters.
 - ii. High school advisors for Sources of Strength went through advisor training.
 - d. CTE: Brooks shared that the following Career and Technical Education (CTE) departments will participate in a program review this year, beginning on August 28th when the Department of Workforce Development visits to share trends and projections for the State of Wisconsin:
 - i. Technical Education
 - ii. Family and Consumer Education
 - iii. Business Education
 - iv. Agriculture
