

## ***IMPORTANT FORENSICS INFORMATION!!!!***

On Friday, February 7th we will have our next forensics competition at SLINGER MIDDLE SCHOOL. Please read ALL of the information below to ensure you are prepared for the meet.

- Make sure you are prepared to present (*If your category requires props, costumes, script, etc, be sure you have those with you. YOU are responsible for your property and presentation.*)
- Dress up (*Ladies: Dresses, Skirts, leggings, or dress pants with a nice top Boys: Dress pants or khakis with a nice shirt*) **No Slinger clothes allowed!**
- Communicate with your parents to assure they will be ready to receive your phone call and be able to retrieve you from SMS promptly.
- Food - \*\*\*\*Reminder that food and drink are **NOT** allowed in the gym!!!\*\*\*\*
  - Meals are available in the cafeteria (pizza, nachos)
  - Bring cash if you would like to purchase additional candy, chips, or drinks.

### **EXTRA RESPONSIBILITIES AS A HOST MEMBER**

- Please be sure that if furniture gets moved in your competition room it gets moved back at the end of the round
- No roaming the school just because you go here. Report to your competition rooms at the designated time, otherwise stay in the cafeteria and gym

- *Cell phones are turned OFF in competition rooms.*
- *Be respectful in the hallways. Just because your room is done does not mean all of them are. **No talking or running in the hallways.***
- *Be conscious of your belongings. Do not leave valuables unattended.*
- *Stay in contact with SMS judges if you experience any problems or changes of plans.*
- ***You must check out with a coach before you leave.***
- *Remember you are representing our school. Any violation of behavior could result in your removal from the forensics team.*
