Board Compensation

School Board members will receive compensation for the following activities:

Regular & Special Board Meetings:

- All regular and special School Board meetings will be compensated at the "Board Meeting Rate" as approved annually at the Annual Meeting.
- School Board members must be in attendance for more than 50% of the meeting to be compensated.

Committee Meetings:

- All committee meetings will be compensated at the "Committee Meeting Rate" as approved annually at the Annual meeting.
- School Board members must be in attendance for more than 50% of the meeting to be compensated.
- School Board members will be compensated for attending only one committee meeting if a meeting is a combined meeting of multiple committees.
- School Board members will be compensated for attending more than one committee meeting if multiple committee meetings are scheduled on the same day.
- School Board members attending a committee meeting they are not assigned to for the purpose of learning or actively participating will be compensated.

Professional Development / Professional Association Events:

Policy 163 "Board Member Development Opportunities" covers the importance of continuing education and staying current with local, state and national trends in education. In addition, active participation in professional organizations (WASB, NSBA, CESA, etc.) where it is for the benefit of the District either directly or indirectly is valued. School Board members, upon majority vote of the Board, will be compensated for their participation in these events.

- If the event is of a duration of four hours or less, the School Board member will be compensated at the committee meeting rate.
- If the event is longer than four hours, the School Board member will be compensated at the Board meeting rate.

Board Compensation

- If the event the School Board member is attending requires travel the day prior and/or after the start or conclusion of the event, they will be compensated at the committee member rate.
- Participation in any professional development event is a privilege that may be granted, withdrawn or limited at the discretion of a majority vote of the Board.

Non-Compensated Events/Activities:

School Board members are encouraged to participate in the community outside of their board duties. Participation in these events is purely voluntary.

Examples include:

- School district awards ceremonies
- Co-Curricular events
- Honours Inc.
- Fundraisers
- Organizations/Boards/Meetings where participation does not benefit the Slinger School District either directly or indirectly.
