

Slinger School District Parent Notifications and Public Reporting

It is the policy of the Slinger School District that parents have the right to inquire, about: whether their child's teachers have met state qualifications; are teaching out of their field; and if students are served by paraprofessionals, the certification of the paraprofessionals, and the district's policy regarding student participation in any required assessments. Parents are made aware of this policy on the districts webpage. It is the intent that all of the teachers in the Slinger School District meet the state certification or licensure requirements at the grade level and subject area in which they have been assigned, but in the event that a student has been taught by a teacher who does not meet applicable state certification or licensure requirements at the grade level and subject area in which the teacher has been assigned for four or more consecutive weeks, parents will be notified via email or letter with an explanation for why this is the case.

Slinger School District also has a procedure in place for reporting out student achievement on all state required assessments, including the Forward Exam, ACT, Dynamic Learning Maps and ACCESS for ELs, if applicable. In regards to the state assessment results as reported in WISEdash, the Slinger School District informs parents and the community of the district level performance, as well as individual school level performance. Communication is via the school webpage, the local newspaper and at a school board meeting.

Finally, the district informs parents and the public about information on any additional assessments required by ESEA (Wisconsin Forward Exam, Dynamic Learning Maps, ACT with Writing, ACCESS, and the National Assessment of Educational Progress), other assessments required by the state (ACT Aspire and the Assessment of Reading Readiness), and where feasible, assessments required by the LEA. The notification includes: participation requirements, subject matter, purpose, when and where such information is available, assessment time; and the schedule and format for disseminating results.
